

TODAY'S EVACUATION DRILL

As a good Boy Scout would say: Be Prepared! In that spirit, we will perform a short evacuation drill at the end of today's service. Just as when we participated in fire drills at school we want this drill to be taken seriously. The announcement to evacuate will come from the pulpit, and ushers will move into place to direct people down the aisles to an exit. Once outside, **move quickly away from the building**, so others are not trapped inside, waiting to get out. Move quickly and quietly.

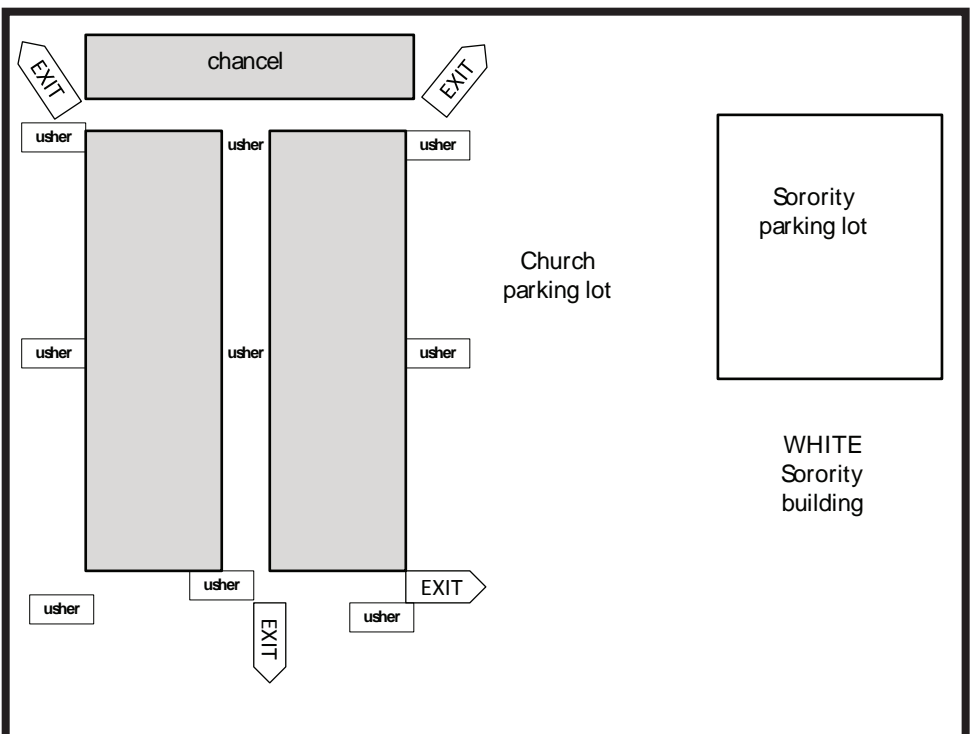
Those with mobility issues will be helped out of the Sanctuary, but for safety's sake, we will not carry them outside as part of this drill. We do ask everyone else to evacuate completely to the outdoors, where the picnic activities will be starting.

Parents of children in classrooms will meet their children in the white sorority building's parking lot, next door. Their teachers will remain with them until you arrive. This too is part of our evacuation drill, and what you can expect should the need to evacuate ever arise.

Those with mobility issues are asked to remain seated until the Sanctuary has emptied. There are two reasons for this: first, we can move people more quickly and safely, from inside to outside, if the flow moves at a steady pace. And secondly, while the majority of people exit, others trained to help, will be able to move into a place near you, to help you exit quickly and safely as well.

Note: Were this a real fire the elevator would not be used to evacuate the building. To be sure all exit safely today, you may use the elevator to exit the building.
